Through thematic lectures delivered by specialists, reflective analyses were conducted on the role of the Organization of American States in view of the upcoming General Assembly in Lima.

The speaker was Dr. Luis Gonzales Posada, a lawyer and journalist, former Minister of Justice, and Ambassador of Peru to the OAS.



(PAC) Panel Discussion: "Guerra en Ucrania - Implicancias en el orden global"



As part of the Cultural Fridays agenda, the Directorate of University Life presented the panel discussion "Guerra en Ucrania: implicancias en el orden global" (War in Ukraine: Implications for the Global Order). The goal was to provide a suitable framework on the conflict between Russia and Ukraine and the economic and geopolitical implications of the crisis resulting from the war.

The speakers included: Mantas Adomedas, a Lithuanian politician; Rafael Casado, Director of the International Relations program; and moderator in charge, Mauricio Novoa, Dean of the School of Human Sciences, who discussed the origin, characteristics, and impact of this conflict on the global order.
